Purpose:

This advice letter filing is being made in order to request approval of the 2017 step increase for San Diego County District in accordance with California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Decision (D.) 15-04-007.

Background:

Submission of these tariffs is made in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 8 of D. 15-04-007 which states:

For escalation years 2016 and 2017, California-American Water Company shall file Tier 2 advice letters proposing new revenue requirements and corresponding revised tariff schedules for each district. The filing shall include rate procedures set forth in the Commission's Rate Case Plan (Decision 07-05-062) for Class A Water Utilities and shall include appropriate supporting workpapers. The revised tariff schedules shall take effect no earlier than January 1, 2016, and January 1, 2017, respectively and shall apply to service rendered on and after their effective dates.

These tariffs are also being filed in compliance with ordering paragraph 13 of D. 15-04-007 which states:

13. California-American Water Company is required to file 2016 and 2017 escalation year filings for each and every district.

This filing also includes an analysis on Cal-Am's low income program per the settlement agreement adopted in D.15-04-007, which states:

...ORA and CAW further agree:

- 1. The program will be a Company-wide program,*
- 2. A surcharge will be based on the parameters and calculations as detailed in the above Rate Design Section 10 of this document,*
- 3. The surcharge will be applicable to all non-low Income water and wastewater customers,*
- 4. The surcharge will be evaluated and adjusted annually in the annual Step rate filings to ensure appropriate collections, and*
- 5. The annual adjustment will be based on calculations as provided in Attachment E-7 to this settlement wherein actual data for discounts, Low Income customers and total customers are inserted into the calculation to replace estimates that are currently shown. Actual data should be through September 30, of the last recorded period.*

Request:

This advice letter filing is to request implementation of San Diego County District's 2017 step submittal. As shown in the supporting earnings test and workpapers for the twelve months ended September 30, 2016, the district earned a rate of return of 8.00% on a recorded basis and 8.23% on a "proforma" basis. The most recent authorized rate of return per D.12-07-009 was 8.41% adjusted to 8.43% to match the designated pro forma period.

In accordance with the Commission staff's procedures for filing step increase, attrition and offset advice letters, since the pro forma rate of return is below the authorized rate of return of the same time period, the district is under earning and is, therefore, entitled to the full step rate increase. California American Water, therefore, respectfully requests a step rate increase in the amount of \$701,463 or 2.60%.

In accordance with Section 4.3 of General Order No. 96-B, a copy of this advice letter is being sent to those entities listed in Exhibit A.

Copies of the detailed workpapers and the documents supporting this Advice Letter have been furnished to the Commission Staff.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

Tier Designation:

Pursuant to D.15-04-007, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

Effective Date:

Pursuant to D.15-04-007, California American requests an effective date of January 7, 2017.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST¹

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this AL. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds² are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

General Items:

- 1. Qualifying low-income customers can receive a discount on their bill. Customers must apply with the Company for acceptance into the low-income program. For additional details, please see Tariff Schedule CA-LIRA.

- 2. Any customer paying for service at a premise where a Residential Fire Sprinkler System (RFSS) is required/requested to be installed by local fire and building codes shall be allowed to have their monthly service charge modified in accordance with the monthly costs for RFSS service charges. Provided, however, that the RFSS rate has been requested by the customer and verified by the Company that the smaller size of meter would be large enough to provide adequate service for the property in absence of the additional demand necessary to supply water to the sprinkler system. The RFSS will not be considered a fire service by the Company, but as an oversized general metered service. As such the rules and conditions of service for general metered service shall apply.

Fees and Surcharges:

- 3. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.

- 4. A surcharge is included on each bill to collect franchise taxes and/or business license fees paid to various municipalities. The amount collected is based on a percentage of gross revenues of each bill. The percentage is 2% to City of San Diego and City of Imperial Beach.

- 5. Per Advice Letter 1072-A, a surcharge of \$0.0054 per 100 gallons will be applied to each bill to fund conservation efforts. The surcharge will remain in effect until otherwise directed by the Commission.

- 6. Per Advice Letter 1138, a surcharge of \$1.21 for the Low-Income Ratepayer Assistance Program ("LIRAP") Balancing Account will be collected from all non-low income water and wastewater customers. (C)

- 7. Per Advice Letter 1108-A, the under-collected balance in the San Diego County District Consolidated Expense Balancing Account (CEBA) will be recovered through a quantity based surcharge of \$0.0338 per 100 gallons over 12 months effective February 1, 2016. The total amount will be recovered from all classes of customers.

- 8. Per Advice Letter 1105-A, a surcharge is applied to each bill to offset increases in purchased water costs imposed by the City of San Diego. This offset results in a needed revenue increase of \$1,960,482 or 7.08%. The surcharge of \$0.0684 per 100 gallons is added to the quantity rate effective January 1, 2016.

Normally, such installation shall be located on the premises of applicant, adjacent to the property line. The expense of maintaining the fire protection facilities on the applicant's premises (including the vault, meter, detector- type check valves, backflow device and appurtenances) shall be paid for by the applicant.
